Francisco along with a handful young architects from New Jersey participated in the NJCCT Carpenter Internship Program. This 30-hour program, provides architectural interns a hands-on experience in interior systems, concrete forms, finished carpentry and mill-shop. Throughout the week, interns learned construction theory from union carpenter in-structors and worked in tandem with union carpenter apprentices to complete small projects in each discipline.
